7. Syllabus for Examination

(a) <u>General Intelligence & Reasoning.</u> The questions will be of 12th standard and would include questions of non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, figure classification, arithmetical numbers series, non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship arithmetical-computation and other analytical functions.

- (b) <u>General Awareness.</u> The questions will be of 12th standard. The questions will be designed to test the ability of candidate's general awareness of the environment around him/ her and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of 12th standard educated person.
